West Central watching SB 309 with concerns

West Central School Superintendent Don Street, along with the school board, are watching a current state bill that could cause the school a future financial loss.

Because of the impact the bill could cause, Street recently testified at a hearing regarding Senate Bill 309. The bill states that after June 30, 2027, electricity suppliers may no longer make net metering traffics available to customers and by March 1, 2026, those suppliers must file a petition requesting a rate for the purchase of distributed generation from customers. The bill was authored by Senator Brandt Hershman and is currently being reviewed by the utilities committee.

Street testified on behalf of the school corporation because of the wind turbine the school owns. Currently, the school has a net metering or a kilowatt for a kilowatt metering system with the NIPSCO utilities.

"My testimony was simply that net metering has really helped us from a financial standpoint," Street said. "If you went away from net metering then we would be buying it for approximately 14 cents and selling it for 4 cents. The board chose the net metering because of the common-sense approach to reducing the required electricity costs."

Street said more than 200 people were at the hearing because it is a hot topic throughout the state. Not only did more than a handful of school representatives attend the hearing, but also a large number of homeowners. The Indiana Small and Rural Schools Association executive director, the Indiana School Boards Association executive director and the Indiana Association of Public Schools Superintendents executive director were also present to testify.

A majority of those who were in attendance were against the bill, while there were a few who were for it. Those who were for the bill were representing utility

Street said other school districts are looking at solar power or have a wind turbine.

"I asked that they would consider grandfathering all schools," Street said.

Street said he believes an amendment was made to

the bill right before the hearing and the amendment was interpreted as those changes would not occur for 15 years.

"Because our payout is more, we need more than 15 years to make it a success story for us," he said. "A lot of people think it will hurt the homeowners and jobs -acreation of jobs."

According to the fiscal impact statement, a report is to be reported to the interim study committee on energy, utilities and telecommunications by Nov. 1, 2018.

The bill requires the Attorney General to adopt rules regarding the installation and ownership of distributed generation equipment.

As part of the fiscal impact statement, it appears that an explanation of local expenditures was not given but local revenues could be affected to the "extent that a local unit received distributions from sales tax revenue." No estimated amounts were given.




