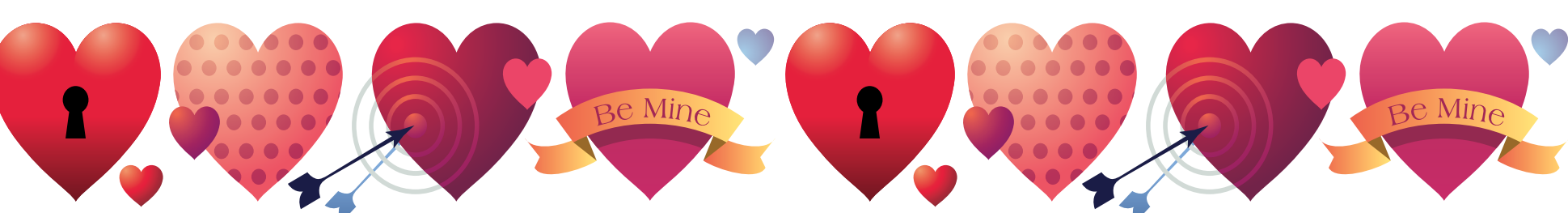

Fierce competition greets Trojans at semistate

Four wrestling semistates took place across Indiana Saturday, Feb. 9, as the last obstacle standing in the way of individuals looking for a spot in the state finals at Bankers Life Fieldhouse in Indianapolis. Three West Central wrestlers advanced to East Chicago Central and had their season come to a disappointing conclusion.

Braden Nuest (120) took his 33 wins to the mat first for the Trojans going up against Lake Central's Sebastian Cortez. Nuest gave a valiant effort but failed to put any points on the board, falling in a 7-0 decision.
