Irrigation systems at work earlier this crop season

Dry conditions mixed with sunshine are causing crops to stress and stunting their growth.

Because of the drier conditions, local farmers are already beginning to use their irrigation systems. Many times those center pivot irrigation systems are not put to use until later in the crop season.

Fields have taken a beating because of the heavy rains in April that delayed planting in May because of ponding.

In a recent article, Purdue Extension corn specialist Bob Nielsen stated that many crops haven't had a chance to get established because of the inconsistent spring weather.

According to the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) crop progress report, about 45 percent of the Indiana corn was in good or excellent condition while about 52 percent of the soybeans are in good or excellent condition. Last year those conditions were about 72 percent.

Locally, Starke/Pulaski Extension Agriculture and Natural Resources Educator Phil Woolery said statewide the county crops are in better shape then those in the rest of the 'Statewide Indiana has been hit with too much water,"

Woolery said. "Pulaski County got hit hard earlier but it's not too bad compared to farther south." Woolery said there are about 18,454 acres in Pulaski County that are irrigated compared to 216,503 farmed acres.

Those statistics are updated every five years. "We are one of the top counties in Indiana for irrigation of the most acres," Woolery said. "That number is from 2012 and that number is probably bigger than that. In Indiana most of the irrigation is in the north/northwest part of the state."

Most of the irrigation systems are about 90-percent efficient, meaning 90 percent of the water will be used by the plants. The 10-percent loss comes from evaporation and watering of roads.

Some center pivot irrigation systems are already being put to work in the county as dry field conditions are stunting the growth of the crops.

Pulaski County USDA Farm Service Agency Executive Director Stefanie Hall said because of the dry fields, the growth of the crops are about a week behind. She speculated the lack of growth is because of the spring weather conditions. The current dryness of the fields is making it harder for the crops to emerge through the soil.

"It is getting a little more critical. They are hoping for a little bit more rain to keep the crops growing," Hall said in regards to the local farmers. "When you get the hot conditions you are looking at more of a drought condition. We are not quite to that point yet to call it a drought."

Hall said she has heard of a couple of farmers who are preparing to use their irrigation systems. She said many farmers have been spraying for weed control and conducting maintenance work on the fields. According to Hall, there are a few surrounding

counties that are worse off than Pulaski County in regards to dry conditions. Some farmers have said they received a nice amount of rain while others have received very little. "Where the rain has been, it has been spotty," Hall

said. "Sometimes the irrigation can help the crops grow a little bit faster especially with the sunshine coming.'

Currently, it is too soon to forecast below-average yields.

Taking precautions against mosquitoes

The first 2017 cases of West Nile virus in humans have occurred in Indiana, and state health officials are urging Indiana residents to take steps to protect themselves from mosquito

to protect themselves from mosquito bites.

As of June 14, two human cases of West Nile virus have been documented in Hamilton and Lake counties, and mosquitoes in Morgan and Tippecanoe counties have tested positive for West Nile virus. The Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) expects to continue to see increased West Nile activity throughout the state as the mosquito season progresses.

"Unfortunately, West Nile disease is a common occurrence in Indiana during mosquito season," said State Health Commissioner Jerome Adams, M.D., M.P.H. "When we find evidence of the virus in multiple counties, that means the risk is starting to increase statewide. Protecting yourself from mosquito bites and eliminating breeding grounds are the best ways to prevent mosquito-borne illnesses."

The following preventive measures are recommended:

- Avoid being outdoors when mosquitoes are active (especially late afternoon, dusk to dawn and early morning).
- Apply an EPA-registered insect repellent containing DEET, picaridin, IR3535, oil of lemon eucalyptus or para-menthane-diol to clothes and exposed skin.
- Cover exposed skin by wearing a hat, long sleeves and long pants in places where mosquitoes are especially active, such as wooded areas.
- Install or repair screens on windows and doors to keep mosquitoes out of the home.
- Mosquitoes breed in standing water. Even a container as small as a bottle cap can become a breeding ground, so residents should take the following steps:
- Discard old tires, tin cans, ceramic pots or other containers that can hold water.
- Repair failed septic systems.
- Drill holes in the bottom of recycling containers left outdoors.
- Keep grass cut short and shrubbery trimmed.

- Clean clogged roof gutters, particularly if leaves tend to plug up the drains.
- Frequently replace the water in pet bowls.
- Flush ornamental fountains and birdbaths periodically.
- Aerate ornamental pools, or stock them with predatory fish.

West Nile virus can cause West Nile fever, a mild form of the illness, which can include fever, headache, body aches, swollen lymph glands or a rash. Some people will develop a more severe form of the disease affecting the nervous system, including inflammation in the brain and spinal cord, muscle paralysis or death. People who think they may have West Nile virus should see a healthcare provider.




