Several locals signed up at the last minute but were not the last to finish the race. Funding from the race will benefit the programs at the park nature center.







## Election board debates how to address new law At-large candidates could lose votes

Pulaski County Election Board members are debating the best way to keep the fall election from becoming a fiasco because of a new election law.

Indiana Senate Enrolled Act 61 that was signed by Governor Mike Pence in March, states that straightticket votes for at-large candidates will not get counted automatically. Straight-ticket voters can still vote for atlarge candidates but must check the ballot and individually fill in offices that may have more than one candidate per party such as at-large county council seats. For the general election that could affect the local results for three at-large county council seats.

"It is a concern, especially when people think it is going to carry down all the local races and it may not indeed do so," said election board vice president Laura Bailey.

President Jon Frain said voters will need to carefully review their ballots to ensure they are voting for the candidates that they support. Election board members will be reminding voters of

the new election law change in upcoming press releases and advertising. According to the act, ballot instructions must be

printed either at the top of the ballot or in the voting booths.

In other business:

- Updates were given on commissioners' and council meetings the election board members attended. During the meetings, the election board requested three transfers and also an increase in stipend for the early voting poll workers. The increase in pay was because the absentee voting poll workers are working more hours per day, have a shorter lunch and are being asked to work more days. "We are asking more of them," Frain said. The transfers included purchasing two new poll pads, covers for those poll pads and advertising for the fall. Those items were approved by both the commissioners and the council.
- Election board members briefly discussed an advertising plan for the fall election. The board would like to share the advertising responsibilities with the two political parties. Each of the entities would pay for two weeks of advertising regarding the election information. It was suggested that the election board advertise the last two weeks, so it does not appear to be party sponsored. "We have to act like nobody knows that we changed anything because some people do not participate in primaries,'

Frain said. "We saw this two years ago when we consolidated on Election Day. People were upset. We are going to have to act like it is brand new to them." He said some voters who didn't vote in the primary two years ago, were unaware of the consolidation. Bailey suggested that the board also address some of the registration issues in a press release such as changes in addresses and if the residents are still registered. Later in the meeting, there was a discussion of military absentee voting. Frain said it needs to be clarified that when service men and women are voting they need to appropriately mark the ballot because "there are different requirements for active military men and women."

- A campaign sign was brought into the meeting. The sign supports one of the presidential candidates but there is no indication of who the sign was paid for by. Some of the signs that are now appearing in residents' yards appear to be homemade. Frain said whether they are homemade or not, "to please make sure that the signage has the appropriate 'paid for by' disclosure on it. To the buyer, beware if you are buying stuff online, know that if it comes without a disclosure you could be violating the election laws." Frain also reminded locals to follow the laws in regards to where the signs can be placed such as not too close to the roads.
- A motion was approved to allow absentee voting to happen in Francesville two Saturdays before the election. The voting will happen at the Francesville-Salem Township Public Library. The facility is Americans With Disabilities Act compliant and has adequate parking. The recommendation will now be presented to county commissioners for approval. "I think this is going to bring more accessibility to the voters," Frain said. The hope is that more voters will take time to vote.
- The board remembered the passing of Ken McFarland, former Winamac Town Board President. Clerk-treasurer Christi Hoffa said there will be a Republican caucus held on July 25 in regards to the open seat on the Winamac Town Council. As of the time of the board meeting, two people have filed for the seat.
- Board members also talked about completing a detailed inventory of the election equipment.
- Minutes from the June 15 meeting were approved.
- The next election board meeting is scheduled for Aug. 3.
