

NOTICE

Pulaski County has been awarded federal funds under the Emergency Food and Shelter National Board Program. Pulaski County has been chosen to receive Phase 34 in the amount of \$3,800 and Phase 35 in the amount of \$3,500 to supplement emergency food and shelter programs in the county. The selection was made by a national board that is chaired by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) with representatives from many organizations including American Red Cross, Salvation Army and United Way.

A local board made up of representatives of the Ladies of Charity, United Way, Salvation Army, Pulaski County Human Services, FEMA, American Red Cross, Association of Churches, persons having received services and local elected officials will determine how the funds awarded to Pulaski County are to be distributed among the emergency food and shelter programs run by local service agencies in the area. This local board is responsible for recommending agencies to receive these funds and any additional funds available under this phase of the program.

Under the terms of the grant from the national board, local agencies chosen to receive funds must:

1. Be private voluntary non-profits or units of government
2. Have an accounting system
3. Practice non-discrimination
4. Have demonstrated capability to deliver emergency food and/or shelter programs
5. If they are a private organization, they must have a voluntary board

Qualifying agencies are urged to apply.

Pulaski County has distributed emergency food and shelter funds previously with Pulaski County Human Services. Public or private voluntary agencies interested in applying for emergency food and shelter program funds must contact:
