

### Looking Back...

### **2011 - 10 years ago**

• About one-fourth of the Star City Regional Sewer District customers have yet to pay bills. Certified Public Accountant Sue Peppers, who is handling billing for the district, told board members Monday that 38 homes have balances of \$92.04. That's the amount owed for two months of partial billing. Once bills are 90 days in arrears the district will pursue a lien against a property.

### 1996 - 25 years ago

- The Winamac Town Council decided Monday at its regular meeting not to change the new town fire ordinance that it passed on Sept. 24. The ordinance has come under much heated debate among community members since its announcement last month.
- Nicole Ezra was crowned West Central High School's 1996 Homecoming Queen at Friday night's game by 1995 queen Nicole Rehn. Ezra is the daughter of Les and Deb Ezra.
- A curbside recycling program will be returning to Winamac and is not expected to add any expenses to town taxpayers. The program is modeled after an effort by the Beta Club of the Winamac Community High School. Town officials will distribute literature detailing the project before it starts.

### 1971 - 50 years ago

- Five retired teachers of Eastern Pulaski Community School Corporation who have taught a total of 185.5 years were honored at a gathering by colleagues Tuesday afternoon at the Winamac Community High School Library. Honored were Ruth Edora Campbell, teaching 41 years, Julie Helen Fagen, teaching 32 years, Vera Harris, teaching 31 years, Elizabeth Frank, teaching 36.5 years, and Everett Roller, teaching 45 years.
- The Northern District Boy Scout Circus, a free show to boost the local United Funds in Pulaski and Fulton counties, will be held Oct. 23 at 7 p.m. at the Rochester Fair Grounds. Cub and Boy Scouts from Fulton and Pulaski counties will be participating in circus type acts demonstrating Scouting skills and Cub activities.
- Robert L. Galbreath, Louis L. Jensen, Harvey R. Gutwein and Gerald L. Stone left by chartered bus for the Indianapolis Armed Forces Examining Station for preinduction physicals Tuesday morning, the local draft board announced.
- Ralph Hamman of the Monterey American Legion Post 399 reported that a total of \$15.40 in merchandise had been stolen from the building. Sheriff George Riley listed missing articles as four cartons of cigarettes, a small amount of change and several keys.
- Winamac's municipal building is presenting a brighter front. Town employees over the past two weeks have painted the main entrance to the office portion after scraping off the old, peeling paint.

### 1946 - 75 years ago

- A committee representing Winamac civic organizations met Tuesday afternoon to discuss ways and means of securing an airport for Winamac under the federal program of the Civil Aeronautics Board.
- Henry Colgrove of Winamac was elected president of the Western Beagle Club at a business meeting of the club held Saturday evening in the Tippecanoe River State

Park shelter house. The club's annual fall field trials, which had 86 entries, were concluded on Sunday. Beagles from the Herbert entries were concluded on Sunday. Beagles from the Herbert Hoch kennels have been entered in the annual fall field trials of the Northwestern Beagle Clubs, which open on Friday in Tippecanoe River State Park.

- Fire burned over about 60 acres of pasture and fields northwest of Winamac Tuesday afternoon, and the Winamac Fire Department spent more than two hours battling it. The blaze started along the railroad and spread into a pasture on the Albert Trapp farm. It burned almost all of that field and had crossed a hay field and parts of two cornfields before it was stopped.
- · Lt. Ivan Haselby arrived home last week after serving two years in the Army, the last year of which has been with the occupation forces in Japan. He is a son of Mr. and Mrs. Firman Haselby of Star City.

### 1921 - 100 years ago

- The grand jury investigation into causes leading up to the death last summer of Miss Lurline Shafer, a Francesville girl of 16 years, led to indictments charging four men with abortion. The accused are Dr. J. F. Noland, a prominent Logansport physician, and Harry Overman, Warren Morgan and Frank Iven, three Francesville men. Warrants have been served upon the three last named, each of whom has given \$2,000 for his appearance in court. Dr. Noland is expected to give similar bond within the next few days.
- "Determined that the four Culver bandits shall not escape punishment in case the supreme court reverses the decision of the Kosciusko Circuit Court, which sentenced them to life imprisonment in the state penitentiary for the killing of J. Russell Saine of Culver. Marshall County officials have taken steps to bring the men back to Plymouth, where they will be arraigned on the charge of highway robbery and assault with intent to kill," says the Plymouth Democrat.

- G.W. Crissinger of Indian Creek came in the other day to swap stories with us and leave some of his silver.
- Felix Whipple and a dollar of his watermelon money parted company last Saturday, but we'll see that he gets full
- Charley Brucker went to Chicago Sunday morning with a marriage license tucked away in his safest pocket, and on Tuesday morning, at St. Bonifacious Catholic Church, occurred his marriage to Miss Edith Bandow, well known and highly esteemed here, where she was employed in Sabel's store for quite a while as saleslady. They came here Wednesday, and will get to housekeeping as soon as they can find a suitable residence.
- F. A. Follmar of Monterey, who holds a responsible position with the company that is now laying a pipeline from the oil fields of Wells County to the vicinity of Chicago, was here Tuesday on business. The line runs angling across Tippecanoe Township to a point a mile or so west of Ora, and then west along the county line on the Starke County side into Jasper County and on to Kankakee, Illinois, where the oil will be refined.
- · Miss Katie Mulvaney was a pleasant caller Wednesday to have the name of her father, James Mulvaney, enrolled for silver news.






